

Grade 10 Course Selections – TDChristian High School

Instructions and Course Options for 2024-25

As a grade 9 student, you need to complete your course selections for Grade 10. Please read and follow the instructions carefully and in order.

Grade 10 students need **six compulsory** credits (English, Math, Science, History, Civics/Careers, Bible) **and two elective courses** (Two of Phys-ed, Art, Music, Drama, STEM, Comm Tech, French, EBlock, and Resource). See the back of this page to rank your elective courses before choosing them in My Blueprint.

- 1) Log-in to your **My Blueprint** account via the Splash! Page. You may need to create a My Blueprint account using your OEN number (located on Report Cards or available from Guidance).
- 2) From Home menu, click on “High School.”
- 3) Add courses to your High School Plan. Courses you have completed and/or are currently taking in Grade 9 should be listed under the Grade 9 column.
 - a. Under the Grade 10 column, click on a **compulsory course** to select a course for that discipline, and click on the appropriate course.
 - i. This will take you to the *Course Information* page where you will see the course description and prerequisite requirements.
 - ii. If you do not have the prerequisite course or mark for the selected course, you will be given a warning. In which case you need to pick another course level (Applied/Academic).
 - iii. If there are no warnings, click “Add Course.”
 - b. Repeat this process until all SIX compulsory subject courses are full.
 - c. See the back of this page to determine your two elective and two alternate courses: choices 1 to 4.
 - d. For your **Elective Courses**, start with your first choice. Then, repeat the steps for your second choice.
 - i. Click on the course.
 - ii. Filter by grade.
 - iii. Select a discipline to view the courses available under each.
 - iv. Select a course to view the course description and prerequisites. If supplementary forms are needed (e.g., application), links to those forms are provided on this page.
 - v. Click “Add Course” if you wish to select and there are no warning messages.
 - e. For **Alternate Courses**, ones you may get if your first two choices do not work out (choices 3 and 4), click on “Alternate Course.”
 - i. Repeat steps in “d.” (above) until all alternate courses are full.
 - ii. Be sure your Alternate Courses are listed in order of preference.
- 4) Make sure you have **10 courses selected** for next year. Your ideal timetable should be listed in the top section, with your two alternate courses, in order of preference at the bottom.
- 5) Once you have selected all your courses, click “**Review Course Selections.**” Make sure there are no issues listed with any of your selections. If there are, go back and edit the necessary course(s) by selecting a different course or level (applied/academic).
- 6) When you are confident, click “**Submit Course Selections.**” Once you click submit, you will be locked out of course selections and will not be able to change your selections on your own.
- 7) Click “**Print Sign-Off Sheet.**” Read and print the sign-off sheet. This sheet needs to be **signed** by you, a parent/guardian, and, if course permission is required, also by that teacher.
- 8) **Submit the Sign-Off Sheet to the office by 9:00 a.m. on Monday, March 4.** Note that your course selections are not complete until the Sign-off sheet and any necessary applications are in the office.
- 9) If you wish to make **any changes to your course selections** once your sheet is submitted, you will need to do so **through your guidance counsellor or by having your parent or guardian email schedules@tdchristian.ca.**
