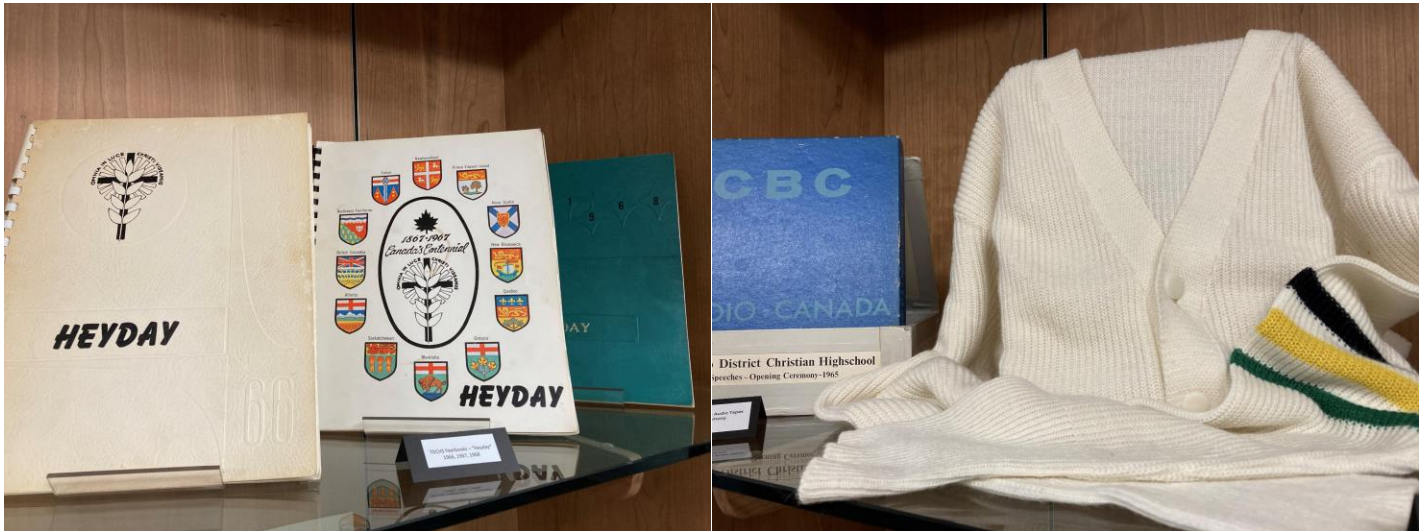

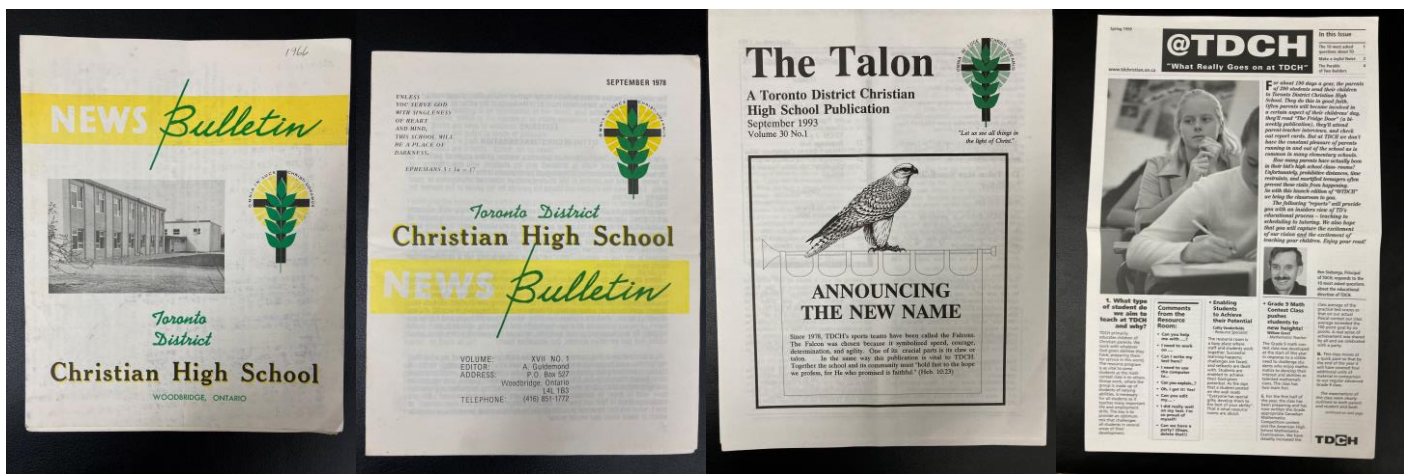

Through the years, TDChristian has maintained communication with parents and supporters through newsletters. The "Toronto District Christian High School News Bulletin" was published regularly through the 1970s, '80s and '90s, until it was renamed "The Talon" in the 1993-94 school year. In 1998, the first "@TD" was published.



Although the archives contain quite a few of these news bulletins, in the 1970s and 1980s very few were saved, therefore many are missing. If anyone in our community saved these bulletins from years ago, and is willing to part with them, we would be happy to add them to our collection.

Archives Collection:

Special collections: For several years, teacher Richard Vanderkloet created small wooden mementoes as gifts for TD graduates. A few examples are pictured here. If you remember receiving a gift at your grad breakfast, and still have it, it would be great if you could send us a photo of the object and the year that it was given.
