#1. As we are hopefully nearing the return to in person learning we need to remain vigilant in our COVID protocols, which includes the bus. Mask wearing is essential to protect those around us. Busses are usually closer proximity, so we need to be mindful of all taking the bus each day, as well as our drivers.

#2. Being in the winter months a reminder that we will send out any bus cancellations using the Call-em-all app that we have set up for each student through text and phone messaging. It will also be posted on the school website. This will be done by 6:30 a.m. at the latest.

#3. The winter weather can also make for unpredictable pick up and drop off times if there are delays/accidents/just general slow downs. We will send out a text update through Call-em-all if there will be a significant delay.

#4. If you are having issues with bus tracking, please email hoving@tdchristian.ca. Mr. Hoving will pass it along to the bus tracking company to troubleshoot.

#5. A reminder that there are currently no bus passes to go on buses other than those assigned to students. Students are permitted to get off at another assigned stop on the same bus they are assigned to if necessary but I do need parental confirmation.

We currently have 14 busses on the road transporting students in from all across the Greater Toronto Area.
