Applying Your Knowledge: Ideologies and Government

Civics 10 Unit: 1

Research a particular country and create a presentation that covers the material below. You may not research Canada or the United States. Your presentation should last 8 minutes. A write-up should be 2 pages and include some useful diagrams.

Your slideshow should be anywhere from 10-15 slides long.

- What the the name of the country?
- What is the population and where is the country located? (provide a small map)
- Give us a few details about the country- so we know more about them.
- Who is the leader? Brief summary (how do they become leader, political background, how long they remain leader for, etc.)
- Identify the system of government and ideology(s) and provide evidence to support each (e.g. Totalitarian— use of secret police...)
- How many political parties are there?
- Include some really interesting fact you learned about this country's government
- In your opinion, do they have a good system of government? Why or why not?
