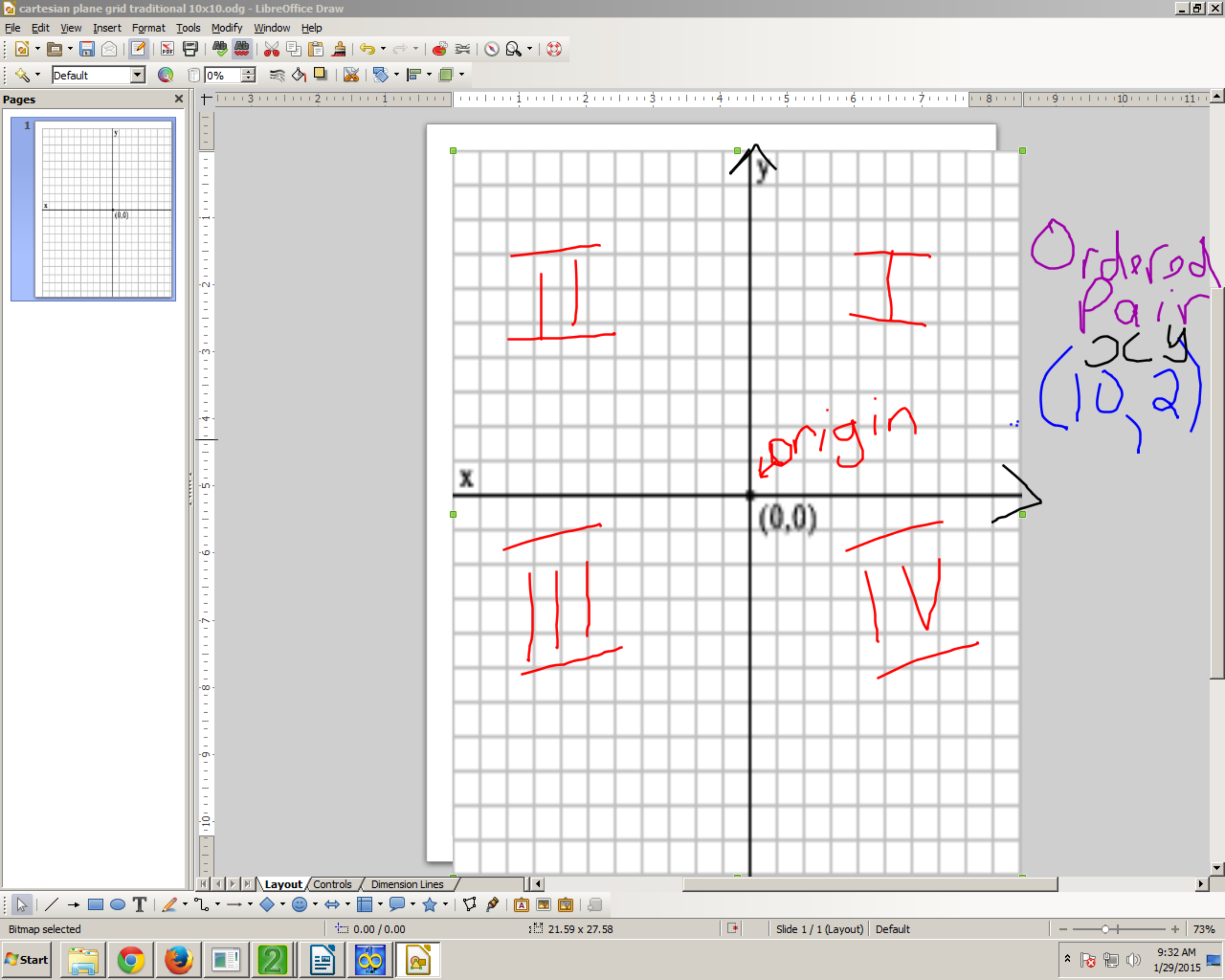
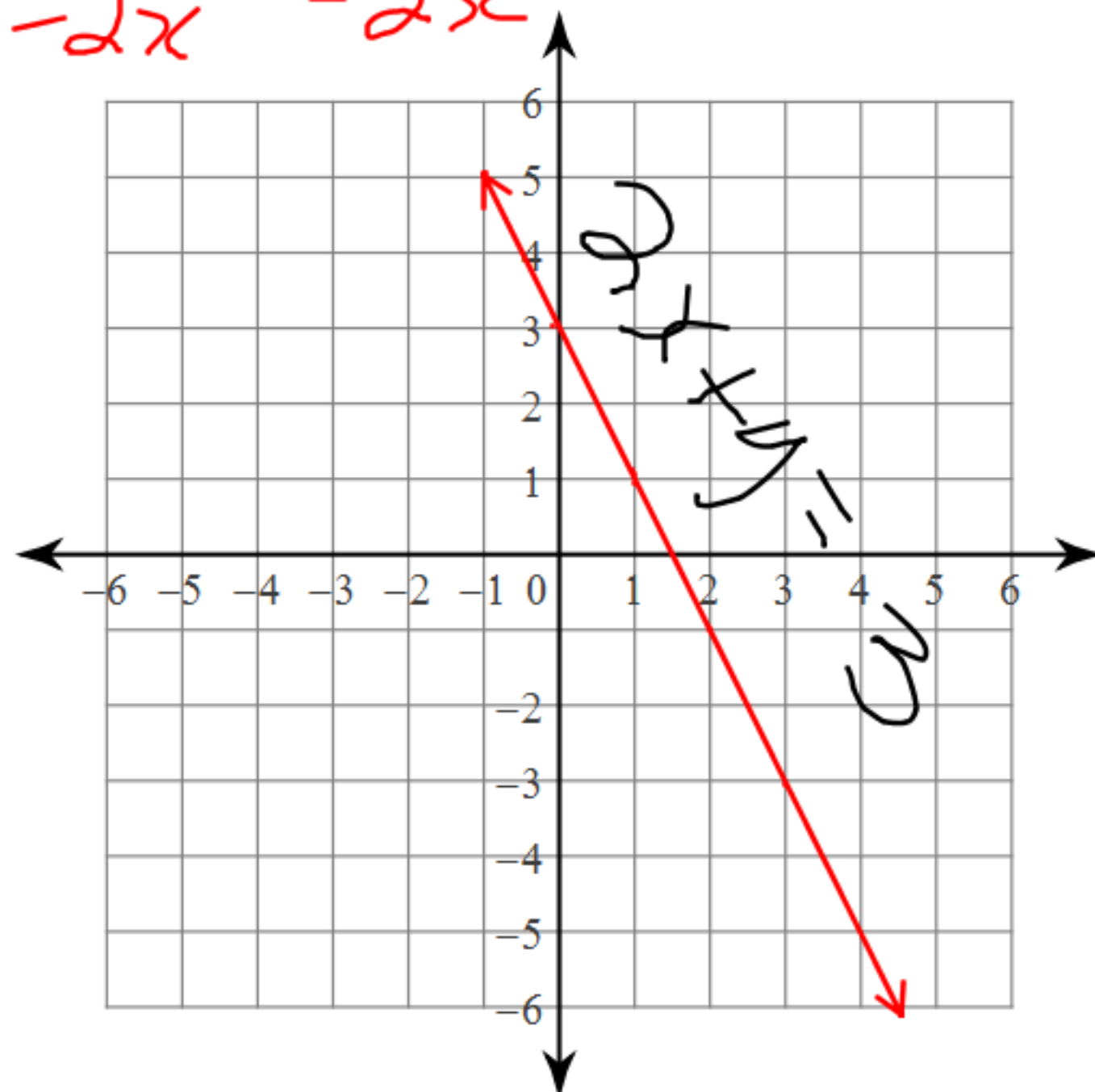




1) $2x + y = 3$

$-2x \quad -2x$

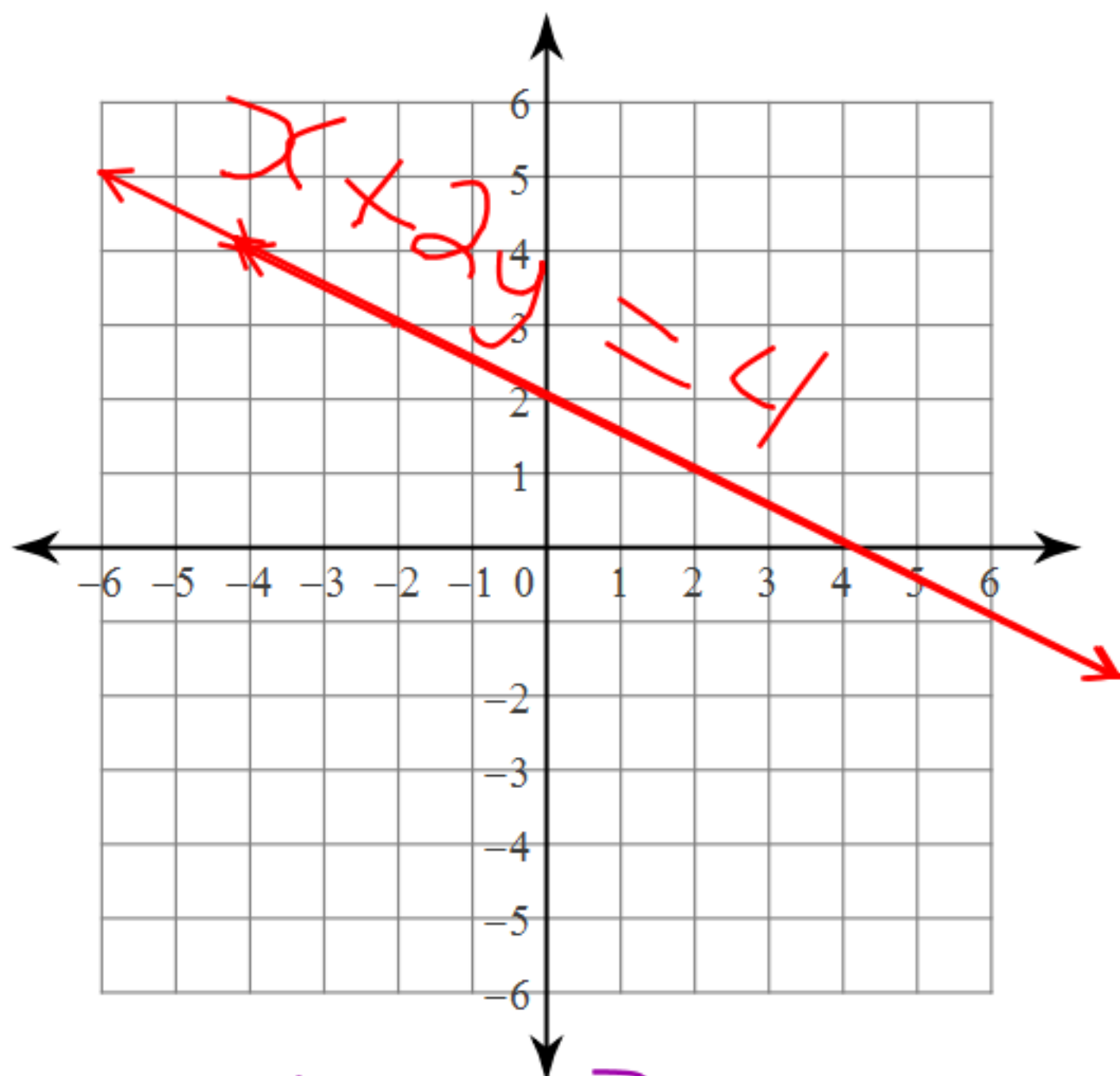

$$\frac{2y}{2} = \frac{-x + 4}{2}$$

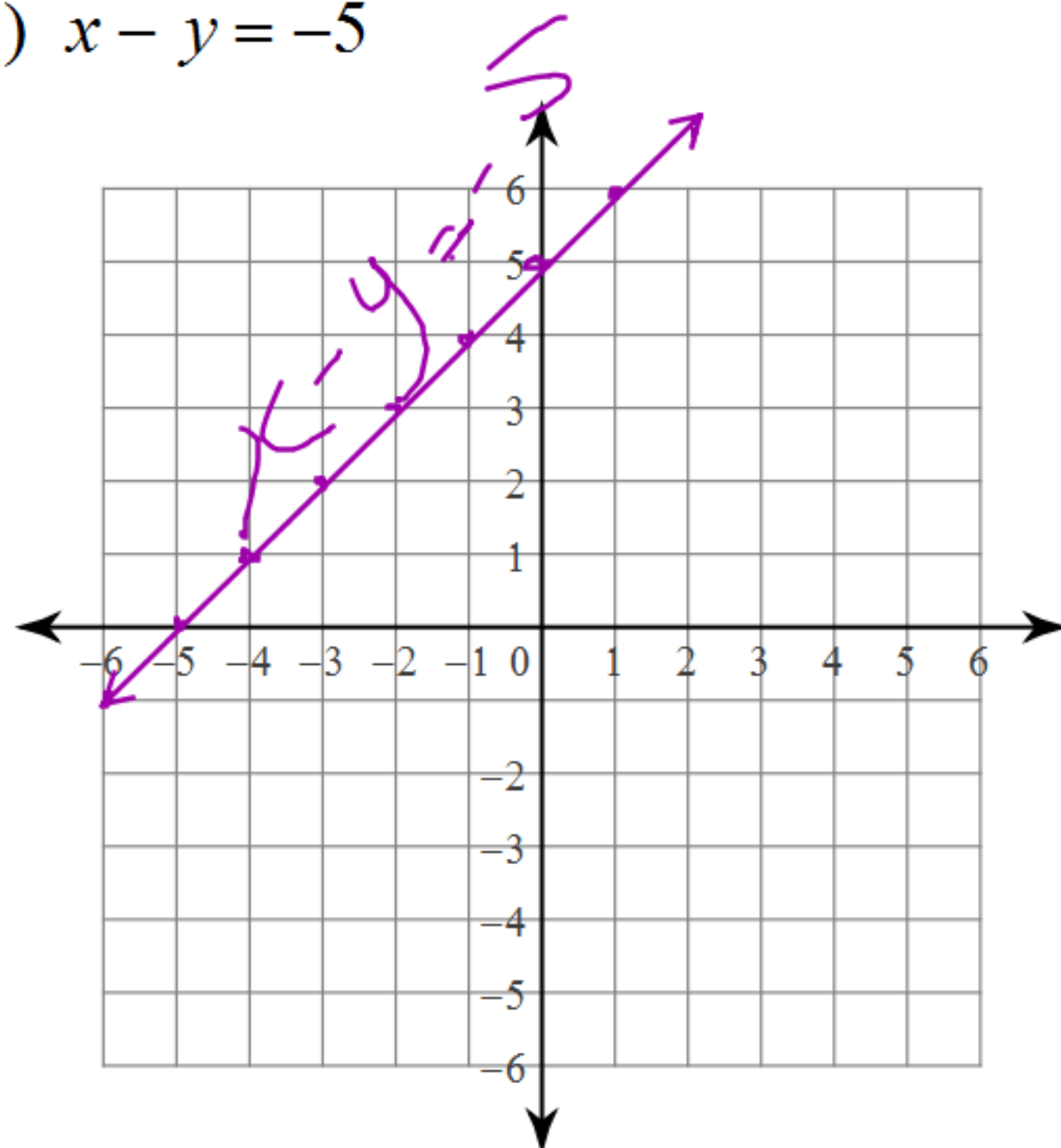
$$y = -\frac{1}{2}x + 2$$

3) $x - y = -5$

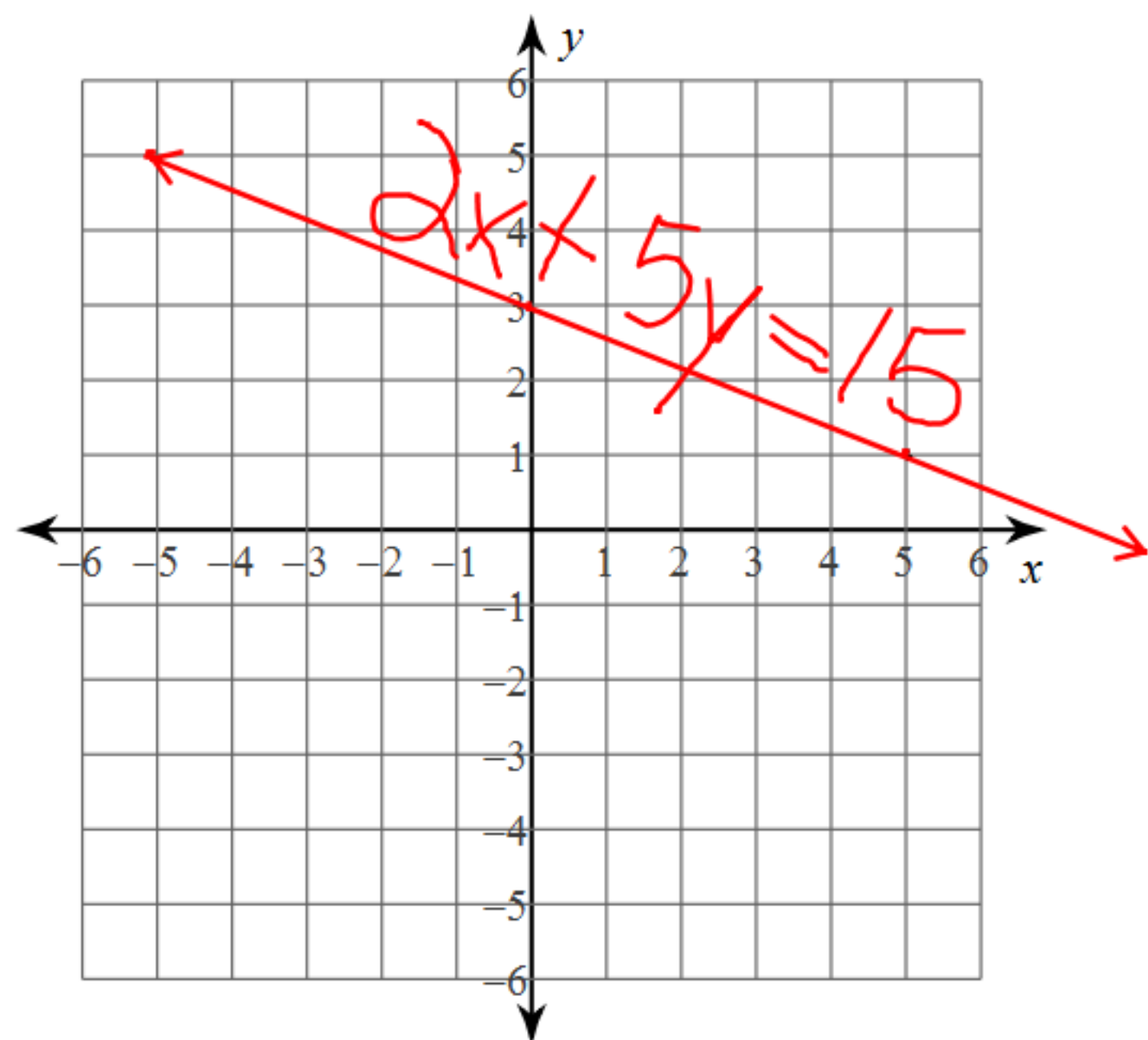


$$x - y = -5$$

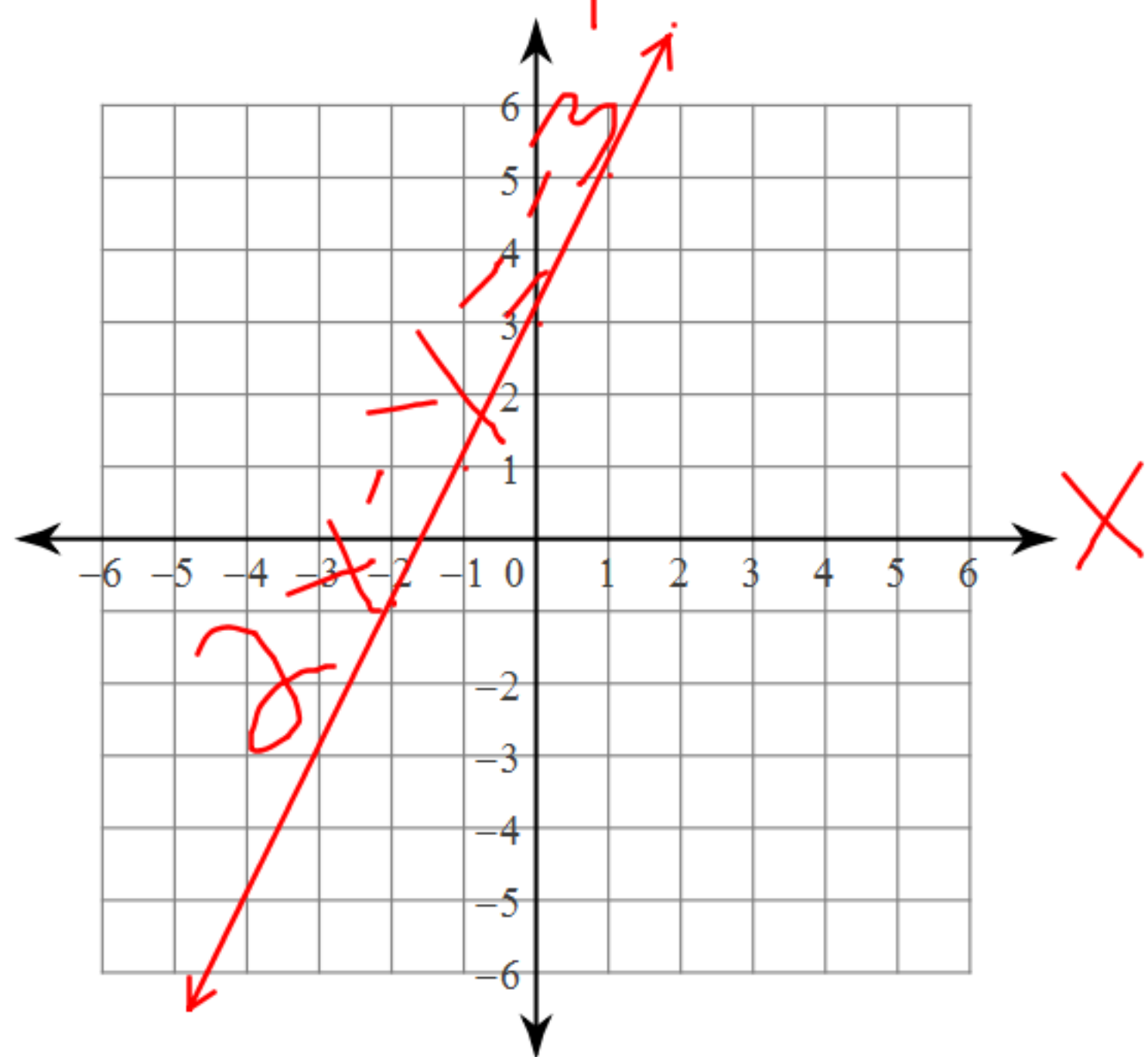

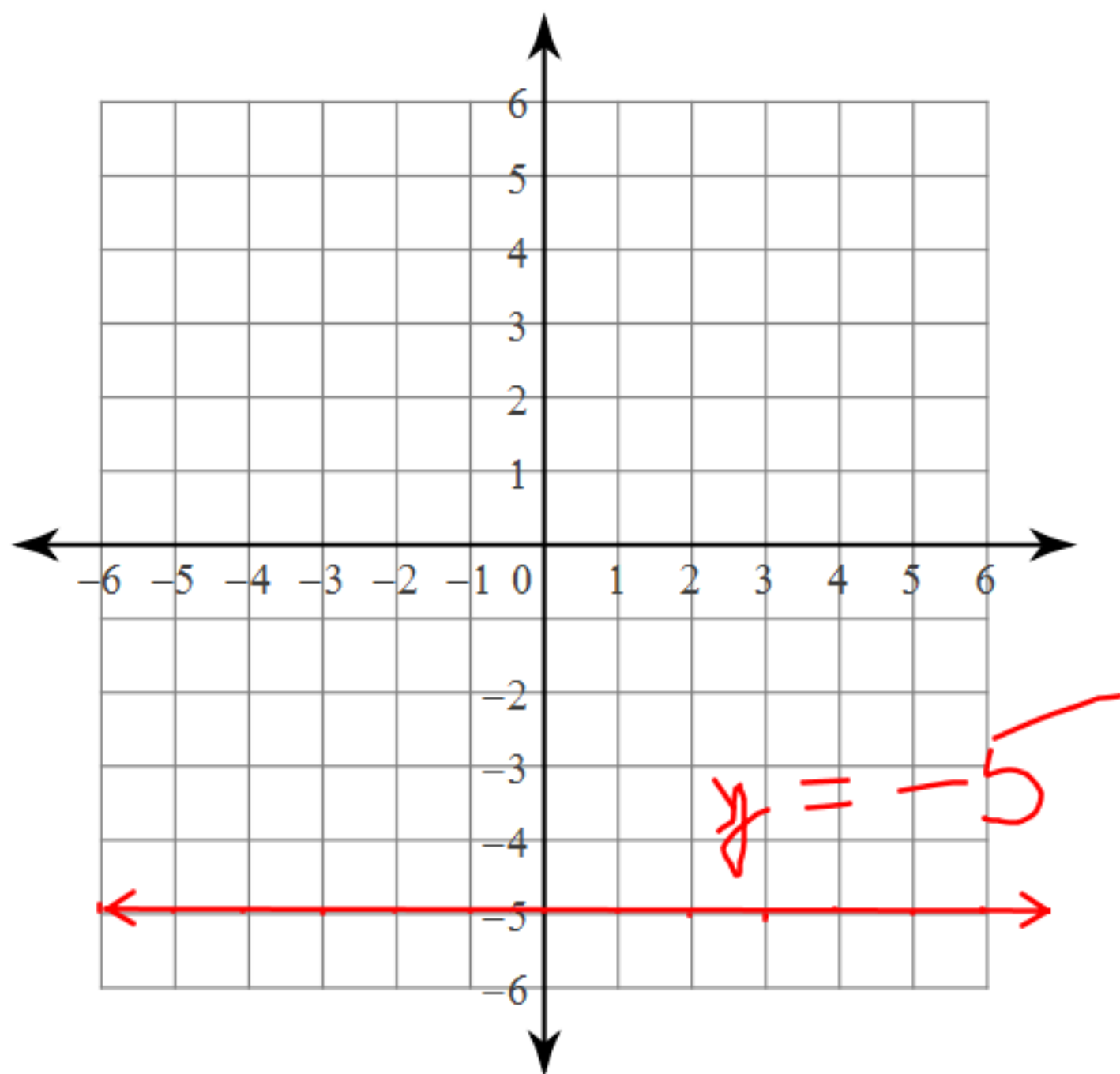
