

Transferring files from school to home, and back again

Students can transfer files from your P: drive and K: drive to a personal laptop or home computer using a file transfer program.

Windows

Download WinSCP (pronounced “Win scape”) here: <https://winscp.net/eng/download.php>

Mac

Download Cyberduck here: <https://cyberduck.io/>

When setting up this file transfer software, it will ask you for some settings:

Server or hostname: gateway.tdchristian.ca

File transfer protocol: SFTP (not FTP)

Username: your school computer username

Password: your school computer password

Port number: 3005 ← this is very important

Once you have it set up, you will see a list of folders. The folder named FILES is your P: drive and the folder named KLASSDRIVE is your K: drive. You can drag and drop files from your desktop to this program.
