

Grade Trips @ TDChristian 2017-18

Grade 9 students participate in a two-day Service Trip to downtown Toronto during the first week in September. The main reasons for these trips are: first, to provide students the opportunity to get to know each other; second, to encourage students to learn for service in the light of God's Word. They work directly with organizations with which TDChristian High School has partnered for years. It is a rewarding experience of volunteering alongside new peers as students begin their high school career at TDChristian. (A complete page providing more details follows in the booklet.)

Grade 10 students participate in a two-day trip to Beacon from Wed., Sept. 27 to Thurs., Sept. 28. This trip is tied to the Careers course which all Grade 10 students take. The main reasons for this trip are: for students to recognize God-given talents in others and in themselves as they continue their journey of learning for service in light of God's word; for students to grow skills in empathy and inclusion so that the grade creates a hospitable and collaborative learning environment; and to provide opportunities for students to connect, or reconnect, positively with others in their class by working together and listening to each other. Grade 11 students participate in the Toronto Service trip during either Semester 1 or Semester 2 as part of their English and Perspectives class or as part of Internship Block. At an in-depth level, students learn about homelessness and communities providing assistance. This trip encompasses the opportunity to tour Toronto neighbourhoods, enjoy different ethnic foods, and listen to a speaker who helps us, as humans and Christians, better understand our role and posture in how to serve others. GRADE 9 TRIP @ TDChristian

Grade 9 students will participate in a two-day Service Trip to downtown Toronto. The main reasons for the trip are:

- 1) to provide students the opportunity to get to know each other,
 - 2) to encourage students to learn for service in the light of God's Word as they work directly with organizations, many with which TDChristian High School has partnered for years.
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- Date:** Trip 1 (male students): Wednesday, September 6 to Thursday, September 7.
Trip 2 (female students): Thursday, September 7 to Friday, September 8.
- Timing:** Arrive at TDChristian High School as normal on the first day of your trip; we will return from the trip in time to catch the school buses home the following day.
- Location:** Stay overnight at Knox Presbyterian Church (630 Spadina Ave., Toronto).
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WHAT TO BRING

Since space on the bus and at Knox Presbyterian Church is limited, please only bring what you need for two days and one night.

- Wear comfortable clothes in which you can work and walk long distances.
- Wear comfortable shoes that are close-toed. **** Important** No open-toed shoes are permitted** (e.g. sandals) as most service locations require close-toed shoes for safety reasons.
- Bring a warm jacket or hoodie sweatshirt.
- Pack a bag lunch for the first day of your trip as you will not be able to purchase a lunch downtown on your first day. The other three meals (dinner, breakfast, lunch) will be provided for you.
- Bring a sleeping bag, pillow, wash cloth, towel, and toiletries.
- Bring two pairs of good condition/quality socks to give to homeless people.

Optional items to bring:

- Rain coat. We will use the underground PATH system or public transit, when possible, if it rains.
- Spending money. We may stop at Wendy's/Tim Hortons on way back to TDChristian at the end of the trip. Absolutely no shopping is allowed downtown.

Rationale:

WHAT TO BRING

- Wear comfortable and appropriate clothes in which you can work and walk long distances. Clothing may get dirty and possibly wrecked. Think modesty, and for your safety, no TDChristian clothing.
- Wear comfortable shoes that are close-toed. **** Important** No open-toed shoes are permitted** (e.g. sandals) as most service locations require close-toed shoes for safety reasons.
- A back-pack for day use.
- A larger bag to hold the rest of your stuff. **** Important**** You will not have access to your main bag & sleeping gear until about 10:00 pm each night. Carry whatever you need for the day with you, including a change of clothes if you don't want to wear your work clothes all evening.
- Bring a warm jacket or hoodie sweatshirt.
- A small bottle of hand sanitizer and some anti-bacterial wipes are a good idea.
- Pack a bag lunch for the first day of your trip as you will not be able to purchase a lunch downtown on your first day. All other meals will be provided for you.
- Bring a sleeping bag, pad or mat (no air mattresses), pillow, wash cloth, towel, and toiletries.
- Bible and pen.
- Your teacher may hold onto your Service Trip booklet for you.

Optional items to bring:

- Rain coat
- Bathing suit – men's showers are open concept; women's showers are two individual stalls.
- Some spending money (suggested amount of \$20.00 - absolutely no shopping is allowed downtown).
