



How to Install Adobe Creative Cloud Applications on Your Personal Devices

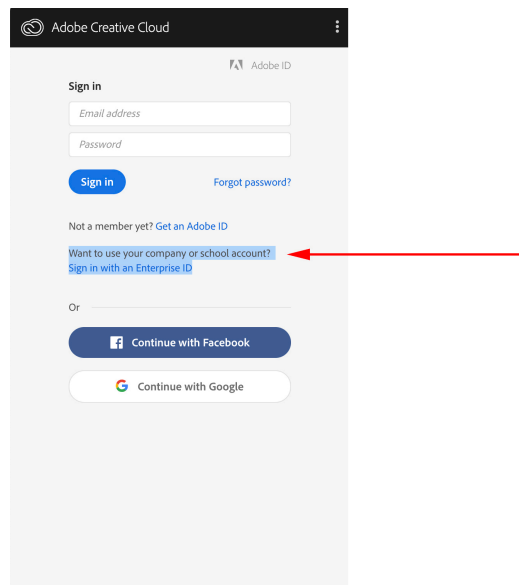
All students of TDChristian High School are licensed by Adobe to install Adobe Creative Cloud applications (such as Photoshop, Illustrator, InDesign) on their personal devices. Here's how:

1. Create an Adobe Enterprise ID

You must have an TDChristian-issued Adobe *Enterprise* ID to log in and download Adobe apps for free. Register for an Adobe Enterprise ID by going to your school webmail account and following the instructions in the Adobe.com email you received with the subject line "Your invitation from Toronto District Christian HS for Adobe software and services." If you don't see this email, ask your teacher about contacting the Tech Department.

2. Download Adobe Apps

- a. Click the link on the Splash page (<https://splash.tdchristian.ca>) to download the Adobe Creative Cloud Installer app (Windows or Mac version). Adobe apps are installed on your computer using the Creative Cloud Installer, not by downloading them individually. Install the Creative Cloud Installer app after the download completes.
- b. Once the Creative Cloud Installer app is installed, launch it and log into it with your Adobe Enterprise ID you created in Step 1 above. Make sure you login on the Enterprise ID login page, not the first login page. See graphic below:



- c. Once logged in, click on the Apps menu item, and select the Adobe apps you would like to install.

Note: An Internet connection is required to download apps. Some apps are quite large and will take some time to download.
